## Honor Flight of West Central Florida

A brief synopsis of this very important activity, to provide WWII veterans free Honor Tours to their memorial in Washington, DC, and it was mentioned at the recent Florida Council of Chapter Presidents Convention, as follows:

. Each WWII veteran has a Guardian, and applications are available.

. The orientation meeting is about 2 weeks before the flight and, on the day of the flight, parties must report at 0500 hours. The tour is only one day, and attendees return home about 2000 hours.

. The visits include the Iwo Jima Memorial, WWII Memorial, Korean and Vietnam Memorial, and observations will be of the Air Force Memorial, US Navy Memorial, The Capital and The White House .

. A wheelchair is available for each veteran, all meals are provided, but Guardians pay their own way.

. The next flight is in April, 2012, and veterans from other states will be in attendance.
