Why Join MOAA?

Persona

- 44 year-old O-5 retiree
- 65 year-old Medicare beneficiary
- 70 year-old SBP/DIC recipient
- 50 year-old military spouse working on a degree
- Retires age <65



Value Added

- \$165K in retirement earnings over 20yrs
- Saving at least \$5K annually in Medicare supplement premiums
- Repeal provides \$12K/year (by Jan '23)
- Full tuition at public university and \$2,000/month avg allowance
- Fought DOD's proposed Tricare Select fee of \$900/year (family) ... Congress backed down to \$300/year
